

JUSTIN CARRIGAN FOOTBALL CAMPS COVID-19 ACTION PLAN

SITUATION MEASURES AND POLICIES FOR CAMPER AND FAMILY MEMBERS

- Camps will be conducted in 5 sessions per day with 60 participants per camp (this provides a 5 to 1 ratio of participants to coaches).
- All participants will be screened prior to camp in accordance to the Texas Health and Human Services Guidelines for Youth Sports Camps. This includes a questionnaire screening as well as a temperature reading. Any participant that does not meet protocols will be sent home and not allowed to participate in the camp.
- It is recommended that family members 65 or over and those with a pre-existing health condition stay at home.
- During camp check-in, all parents and family members will be asked to go to a designated area for seating. It is recommended they maintain social distancing with anyone outside their household.
 - It is recommended that participants wear masks at check in.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for participants to use before check-in, after check-in and at the conclusion of camp.
- Individual water bottles will be given to each participant at check-in; it will also be encouraged that each participant bring their own water bottle for use. An athletic trainer, designated to the water pump station, will refill bottles as needed (nobody else will be allowed to refill water).
- At the conclusion of the camp, parents or family members can pick up the participant outside of the stadium.

SITUATION MEASURES AND POLICIES FOR JUSTIN CARRIGAN LLC STAFF MEMBERS

- All staff members will be screened each day in accordance to the Texas Health and Human Services Guidelines for Youth Sports Camps. This will include a questionnaire screening as well as a temperature reading. Any staff member not meeting protocols will be sent home.
- All staff members will wear a mask during the check-in process.
- Any time a staff member tests positive for COVID-19, all parents will be notified about the possible exposure.
- Each staff member will be required to sanitize hands at the conclusion of each session.
- Justin Carrigan LLC will ask each location to provide a janitor that will clean bathroom areas at the conclusion of camp.
